Commissioner to release report on disclosure of risks to health and safety

VICTORIA – On Monday, Dec. 2 at 9:30 a.m., B.C. Information and Privacy Commissioner Elizabeth Denham will release an investigation report on the topic of disclosures of risks to health and safety and matters in the public interest mandated by section 25 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (“FIPPA”).

The Commissioner’s investigation was initiated in response to a written submission made by the BC Freedom of Information and Privacy Association, which alleged that public bodies were not meeting their obligations under s.25 of FIPPA.
